SCHOLARSHIP POLICY

Scholarship funds will be deposited with the SMART Program, which is administered by the United States Bowling Congress. This program was selected to streamline the process for scholarship winners to access their funds. It will also allow bowlers up to eight years from the date they graduate high school to use the funds. Bowlers will receive e-mail verification from the SMART fund administration after each deposit into their account. All funds fall under the SMART program policies and procedures. POINT TOURNAMENT QUALIFYING FORMAT

All bowlers will bowl two (2) three-game blocks. Position standings will be posted after the completion of each squad. Each 3-game block will be bowled on a different pair of lanes. After the two qualifying blocks, the field will be cut to the top five bowlers in each division for the stepladder finals.

Check-in time for the finals will be **immediately** following the posting of final qualifying scores, and any ties (if applicable) have been decided. The stepladder finals will begin immediately following check-in. If a qualifying bowler is not present at check-in or a qualifying bowler withdraws **prior** to the beginning of match play, the alternate will become the 5th position qualifier. All qualifiers originally ranked lower than the absent bowler will then advance one position. Once the alternate has been added to the top 5, there will be no changes to the finals line up. If match play has begun and a qualifier withdraws prior to his/her match, that bowler will forfeit his/her match and be placed in the lower of the 2 positions he/she would have competed for. If a bowler must withdraw for any reason during match play, the remainder of the game in progress will be forfeited. The winner of the forfeited match will advance to the next match, if applicable. If a bowler must withdraw after completion of a match for any reason, their opponent will advance to the next match, regardless of match outcome. The highest qualifier chooses whether they will finish first or last. The bowler finishes last bowls first, on the odd numbered lane. First round match qualifiers will have the opportunity for 5 minutes of practice before the match begins. Each subsequent qualifier will be allowed two practice balls on each lane before their match begins. Advancing bowlers will not receive additional practice rolls.

Junior Gold: if possible, Kansas City Open (KCO) will sponsor Junior Gold (JG) youth divisions qualifying at each point tournament. Bowlers must show current JG membership card before each tournament. If a bowler does not have their current JG membership card, they can purchase one on the day of the tournament.

A JG membership consists of bowlers who **MUST**:

- Be a USBC youth standard member in good standing and maintain compliance with USBC Rule 400.
- Purchase an additional JG membership separate from regular USBC youth standard membership.

Unless a valid card is displayed prior to each tournament, that bowler will not be allowed to bowl JG qualifying in that KCO point tournament.

- Bowler's whose birth date is 08/01/2014 or later will participate in the U12 division. U12 JG membership fee is \$25.00 and entry fee for each U12 bowler at each tournament is \$37.50.
- Bowler's whose birth date is 08/01/2012 – 07/31/2014 will participate in the U14 division. U14 JG membership fee is \$40.00 and entry fee for each U14 bowler at each tournament is \$50.00.
- Bowler's whose birth date is 08/01/2010 – 07/31/2012 will participate in the U16 division. U16 JG membership fee is \$50.00 and entry fee for each U16 bowler at each tournament is \$62.50.
- Bowler's whose birth date is 08/01/2008 – 07/31/2010 will participate in the U18 division. U18 JG membership fee is \$50.00 and entry fee for each U18 bowler at each tournament is \$62.50.

Each division are combined competitions unless able to separate by gender without turning away any bowlers. The number of spots awarded is determined the day of the tournament based on the number entries that day per division. JG is a scratch tournament and each bowler's six games qualifying scores of the KCO tournament will be used. KCO qualifies 1:4 ratios to entries per division. Ties that need to be decided for qualifying advancers and/or first non-qualifier spot will be decided by a 9th and 10th frame roll-off prior to KCO Stepladder final matches. The first non-qualifier above initial ratio with excess entries in each division can advance by paying funds to complete the entry fee. JG qualifier will not be held during the KCO Youth/Adult tournaments and the Invitational Scholarship tournament.

KANSAS CITY OPEN

TOURNAMENT RULES – 2026 / 2027

Entry & Competition Rules / Fees

1. The Kansas City Open is a **USBC Youth Sanctioned** tournament. All entrants must have a USBC Youth Sanction Membership. If necessary, USBC Youth sanction standard membership can be purchased through the KCO on the day of the tournament. All bowlers must fill out a sanction card at their first tournament of the current season for our records. All bowlers with guardian for minor bowlers must sign release waver before competing. Previously signed releases on file are good if no information has changed. All tournament rules follow in accordance with and comply with and are governed by USBC Youth rules.
 - a. Only **one entry** per bowler per tournament is allowed.
 - b. **Falsifying membership** will result in disqualification and loss of any scholarship awards and entry fees for all tournaments bowled while found ineligible.
2. **ENTERING AVERAGE** for KCO tournaments will be:
 - a. **KCO Carryover:** Average for bowlers who qualified for the 2026 invitational scholarship tournament provided USBC Rule 319a2 does not apply. This states: “When the previous season’s average is used, and at the time of bowling an entrant has a current average for 21 or more games that is 10 pins or more higher than the prior season’s average, the current average must be used.”
 - b. **New Bowler:** Defined as a first time KCO tournament bowler or bowler that did not qualify for the previous season’s invitational scholarship tournament. Your entering average will be based on:
 - 2026 – 2027 Current highest sanctioned league average at time of participation based on a minimum of 12 games bowled; if not, then use:
 - 2025 - 2026 Highest sanctioned league average of 21 or more games bowled this includes summer leagues; if not then, if applicable, can use:
 - Verifiable Sanctioned High School Highest Average from 2026-2027 school year are accepted with minimum of 12 games bowled. Sanctioned high school bowlers will be subject to USBC Rule 319a2 and rerated as needed. (See KCO Rule 2a above for more information.)If none of these above apply, the bowler must bowl scratch until a KCO average is established.
 - c. **Falsification/Error on an entering average for ALL bowlers:** Bowlers are responsible for verifying their own average, whether submitted by themselves or others. If the submitted entering average is lower than required and results in a lower classification or more handicap, the bowler’s handicap scores will be disqualified unless rerated. If the submitted average is higher than required, prize winnings will be based on the submitted average. Exception are bowlers who accepts being rerated by tournament official, KCO Rule #6.
3. **KCO Average for All Bowlers:** After a bowler’s first tournament of the current season, their KCO average will be established or reestablished based on the total scratch scores of those games bowled. Entry into all subsequent events of the current season, bowlers will use their KCO average. All subsequent averages will be calculated and based solely on the current season’s total pin fall/games bowled in all events. Except bowlers who have signed to be rerated to a higher average which includes handicap change and higher division placement.

4. **USBC Rules 319a4, 319d, and 319e** do not apply.
5. **KCO Calculated Average** errors will be corrected immediately upon discovery. This includes bowler's average, handicap, and division placement.
6. **Tournament Officials** reserve the right to refuse any entry; the right to re-rate an average prior to the bowler's participation/start of the current tournament which includes bowler's handicap, and division placement. The right to make an interpretation and decision on any rule, discrepancy and/or conflict that might arise.
7. **KCO Divisions by averages:**
Division 1 – 200 and Over – Scratch
Division 2 – 180 – 199 – Handicap
Division 3 – 160 – 179 – Handicap
Division 4 – 140 – 159 – Handicap
Division 5 – 139 and below – Handicap
8. **Handicap** for divisions 2 through 5 will be based on 90% from the top of their divisions.
9. If **Less than 6 Bowlers** are in a division, the bowlers will be combined with another division. Handicap for consolidating a division will be 90% of the higher division. If division 1 needs combining, it will be combined with division 2. The new division 2 handicap will be from 210.
10. **“Back-to-Back”** squad bowling will not be permitted. Pacers will not be allowed. No bumpers allowed either.
11. **Membership Fee** of \$10.00 per bowler - payable at first season tournament bowled (this money is used as expenses primarily to pay for website and mailing cost).
12. **Entry Fee Breakdown:** Bowling Fee \$18.00, Award Fee \$20.00, Expense Fee \$2.00 = \$40. The tournament entry fee is due and payable at tournament check in. Optional prepayment of fees is through our website, which is at the same times as the website registration entries times, (See KCO Rule 13a below) and the prepaid fees are nontransferable and nonrefundable.

13. **Entries:** For all tournaments EXCEPT for the Invitational scholarship tournament, bowlers may enter the KCO via:
- Website Entries: Bowlers may enter by using the entry form on the Internet at: www.kansascityopen.com. This entry method is available from the first Wednesday after a tournament until it closes, normally midday on Thursday prior to the upcoming tournament.
 - Entry at any KCO Tournament. Bowlers may register for the next tournament during the current tournament.
 - In case a tournament is canceled for any reason(s), all entries meeting KCO Rule 13a or 13b will count towards invitational scholarship tournament qualification.
 - Late Registration:** Only entries not meeting KCO Rule 13a or 13b deadlines will be deemed late registration and the late registration fee of \$5 will be assessed and added onto the tournament entry fees on tournament day. All additional fees collected from late registration will be added to the award fund for the current tournament season. Walk-on registration will be permitted only if spots are available. If no spots are available a waiting list will be established. If spots become available prior to squad time they will be filled in the order bowlers are placed on the list. Spots will be considered available based on KCO Rule 14.
14. **Registered Entries:** Will hold a spot in monthly tournaments up to 10 minutes prior to squad time. If you have reserved a spot and have not checked in or notified tournament management that you are running late, then 10 minutes prior to squad time you will be considered a “no show”. Officials may then fill your spot with bowlers from the waiting list established per KCO Rule 13. If you are not going to bowl and you have reserved a spot, you must notify tournament management before your reserved squad start time or you will be charged a \$5 “no show” fee. This fee must be paid prior to your participation in future Kansas City Open Tournaments. All “no show” fees collected will be added to the award fund for the current tournament season.
- “A” squad starts at 8:45am with announcements and practice, check in begins at 7:30am
BOWLERS must check in wearing clothing as stated in KCO Rule #15 Dress Code
 - “B” squad starts at 10:15am with announcements and practice, check in begins at 9:00am
BOWLERS must check in wearing clothing as stated in KCO Rule #15 Dress Code
15. **Dress Code:** All youth competitors shall wear an appropriate bowling shirt.
- All shirts must have finished sleeves.
 - All youth competitors will be required to wear full-length slacks or pants.
- Youth competitors shall not wear apparel or use equipment depicting alcohol, tobacco, and/or gambling during competition. Images, products, and/or activities containing profanity, inflammatory or obscene language or imagery will not be allowed. All apparel worn by competitors shall:
- Be free of rips, tears, and holes.
 - NOT be constructed from denim, fleece, or Lycra/Spandex fabrics.
- Coats, jackets, or any type of outer garments cannot be worn over the bowling shirt while competitor is on the bowling approach. Hats, sunglasses, and/or any type of headgear, including electronic devices, cannot be worn, or used while competitor is in the bowling area. **Bowlers will required to change if attire is deemed inappropriate.** Tournament officials have the final decision.

16. All **Award Funds** that count toward the invitational scholarship tournament will be returned 100% in awards and scholarships at a ratio of at least one award for each ten entries.
 - a. The Kansas City Open directors reserve the right to run optional handicap brackets at any or all tournaments except the Youth/Adult tournament. Handicap will be based on 90% of 220. When brackets are run, the **Bracket Award Fund** will be returned 100% in scholarship awards at the end of each tournament. Funds will be deposited into each winner's USBC SMART account. There will be a first and second place winner in each bracket. Brackets will be comprised of eight bowlers. The cost will be \$3.00 per bracket. A bowler can bowl in as many brackets as they like. First place in each bracket will be \$18.00 scholarship, and second place will be \$6.00 scholarship. Brackets are only open at initial check-in for each squad.
17. **All ties** that need to be resolved will be decided by a 9th and 10th frame roll-off to include two-tenths of the bowler's total game handicap if applicable. Standard policy on who starts first is the bowler who has the highest scratch series, of three scratch games bowled in the qualifier, has the option to start first on the left lane to finish last, or start second on the right lane to finish first. If tied again after a roll-off and or a tie after a stepladder match, bowlers will start on same lane they just finished on and by rule left lane starts first.
With the only exception, if there is only one tie for fourth place after qualifier, then the standard policy applies, as stated above, to begin match play of the stepladder finals without a roll-off.
18. **Scoring or tournament procedure issues:** Scoring errors or obvious pin errors must be corrected by a center employee or tournament staff immediately upon discovery. If any questionable errors occur, play needs to stop immediately and tournament staff must be notified to resolve the problem before bowling continues.
19. **Alcohol and Tobacco Products.** Competitors are not allowed to use any type of tobacco products during competition while in their bowling attire. Failure to comply with this rule will result in a verbal warning. A second offense will result in disqualification from the tournament. Consumption of alcoholic beverages and/or use of illegal drugs by any participant at any time will result in disqualification from the tournament. No youth bowlers may enter the bar area without a parent or guardian present. Tobacco & Alcoholic Consumption by spectators will be restricted to DESIGNATED AREAS ONLY IF AVAILABLE.
20. **Bowling area:** Limited to bowlers competing in current qualifying squad or active match play, scorekeepers, and tournament officials. Tournament officials will define the bowler's area during announcements.
21. **Food:** Will not be permitted in bowling area.
22. **Foul, Abusive Language, Gestures and/or Threatening Behavior** will not be permitted at any time. Violation is subject to KCO Rule 24 enforcement.
23. **Abusing the Center's Equipment** will not be permitted at any time. Violation is subject to KCO Rule 24 enforcement.

24. **Competitors who violate** tournament rules and/or participate in conduct derogatory to USBC YOUTH rules are subject to immediate ejection and disqualification, disqualification from one, or all remaining tournaments for the current season and/or permanent suspension from the KCO and/or USBC.
25. **Protests and Appeals:** All decisions of the tournament officials are final unless an appeal is made in accordance with USBC Rule 329.

AWARDS

26. **Monthly Division Champions** will have the option to purchase a bowling shirt, or a jacket selected by the Kansas City Open directors. Payment for these shirts or jackets must be made in full before the shirt or jacket can be ordered. The lettering on each garment will include the KCO logo, champion, the year of the current tournament season, and the name of the bowler. Only one shirt or jacket purchase is allowed for each monthly division winner, but a bowler will be allowed to purchase a shirt or jacket each time they are a monthly division champion. If a bowler does not purchase a shirt or jacket at the time, they win a division, they will be allowed to purchase a shirt or jacket until the end of the current season. Exception is invitational champions extended purchase through the October tournament of the following season. The KCO directors will make every effort to have the shirts or jackets available at the next point tournament. All awards will be destroyed if not picked up within a year of purchase.
27. **All Stepladder finalists (1 – 6)** will receive a scholarship award. All six finalists in each division must sign in at their assigned lanes to be eligible for stepladder awards. The breakdown for each division will be \$120 for first place, \$90 for second place, \$65 for third place, \$45 for fourth place, \$30 for fifth place, and \$20 for sixth place alternate only if the alternate is not being used in stepladder match play. If fewer than 96 bowlers participate, the amounts in each division will be adjusted downwards based on the total number of bowlers for that tournament. The top five monthly stepladder finalist will receive a plate indicating the place and division they finished in for that tournament. Each stepladder finalist will have the option to purchase a plaque with their name on it. Only one style plaque will be offered. The KCO will make every effort to have the plaque at the next point tournament. All awards will be destroyed if not picked up within a year of purchase.
28. **Individual USBC Honor Score Awards** the KCO will provide appropriate documentation of the award that can be taken to the bowler's regular youth center. If a bowler does not bowl in a regular league, they can send the documentation into USBC themselves.
29. Bowlers with **Perfect Attendance** will receive a scholarship award. Perfect attendance is defined as participating in all point tournaments in a season.

KANSAS CITY OPEN

TOURNAMENT RULES – 2026 / 2027

30. The **Season Point** leader in each division will receive a scholarship award provided they have qualified for invitational scholarship tournament. All participants will receive 10 points per point tournament bowled, plus stepladder points if in stepladder finals. Participants in 4 or more-point tournaments will receive 10 additional points per tournament for all tournaments beyond and including #4. If a bowler participates in 7 or more-point tournaments, they will receive 20 additional points per tournament for all tournaments beyond and including #7.

Example:

Susan bowls in 7-point tournaments. She receives 70 (10 for tournaments #1 – 10) + 40 (10 points for tournaments #4 – 7) + 20 (for tournament #7) = 130 points.

John bowls in 4-point tournaments. He receives 40 (1 – 4) + 10 (for tournament #4) = 50 points.

Points will be awarded in stepladder finals as follows:

1st = 40, 2nd = 31, 3rd = 22, 4th = 13 & 5th = 9.

- a. If a bowler bowls a **majority** of their point tournaments in a division, the bowler will compete for season point awards in that division. If they bowl an **equal number of point tournaments** in more than one division, the bowler will compete for season point awards in the division where they accumulated the most points.
 - b. All tournaments are **Point Tournaments** apart from Youth/Adult and Invitational Scholarship tournaments.
31. The **Invitational Scholarship Tournament** in June will be by invitation only. To qualify for an invitation, you must have participated in at least five point tournaments or four point tournaments and one youth/adult tournament during current season. If more than one youth/adult tournament is held during this season, only one will be counted towards invitation qualifications. Invitations are given to participants who have qualified at the May point tournament. Qualified bowlers not attending May's tournament, invitations are then mailed. KCO Rule #9 is waived.

Please Note: Invitation letter/form for entries can be either mailed in, turned in at the May Point Tournament, or Emailed to: entries@kansascityopen.com, normal web site entries not available. All mailed entry forms must be received by the Thursday before the tournament or they will be deemed as late and assessed a late registration fee.

NOTICE: Any bowler who has an invitation will not be denied entry on the day of the tournament if a spot is available. Walk-on fees are \$5.00 plus entry fees. (\$45.00 total)

- a. The **amount of scholarship** money awarded at the annual invitational scholarship tournament could vary from year to year.
- b. Bowlers not qualifying for the stepladder finals ("non-qualifiers") are eligible for a scholarship award generated from each division award fees collected at this invitational tournament. KCO will pay out scholarship awards separately by divisions to those bowlers of at least a ratio of 1:3. The value of this invitational scholarship award could vary from year to year.
- c. Optional promotional incentive scholarships may be available and could vary from year to year.

Youth/Adult Rules

- YA1. In addition to all rules for the KCO Tournament Rules applying to the youths in the Youth/Adult Tournament, the following will also apply except where noted for adults only.
Youth/Adult Divisions 4 and 5 will bowl on SATURDAY Only! Divisions 1, 2, and 3 will bowl on SUNDAY Only!
- YA2. **Sanctioning:** The Kansas City Open Youth/Adult tournament is an **USBC/USBC YOUTH Sanctioned** Tournament. Adult bowlers must be USBC members and show a membership card before each tournament. Adult sanction cards for Kansas or Missouri local associations must be purchased through the KCO if not in a sanctioned USBC League. Tournaments will be governed by USBC/USBC Youth rules.
- YA3. **Tournament Entry:** Only one entry per youth bowler is allowed. This means a youth bowler can only bowl with one adult. An adult bowler can only bowl with one youth in the tournament each day. This means the same adult bowler can bowl each day with a different youth bowler.
- a. **ADULT ENTERING AVERAGE:**
- Last year's highest sanction average of 21 or more games bowled as listed on bowl.com; (if none then use,)
 - Current highest sanction league average of 21 or more games bowled; (if none then,)
 - Bowl scratch which is 220
- b. Adult bowlers must show proof of average at check-in or bowl scratch if average has not already been verified by tournament official.
- c. USBC rules 319a2, 319a4, 319d, and 319e do not apply for adults
- YA4. **Entry Fee Breakdown:** Bowling Fee \$28.00, Award Fee \$48.00, Expense Fee \$4.00 = \$80
- YA5. **Division Placement:** The division the Youth/Adult team bowls in, will be determined by the youth's average like any KCO youth point tournament.
- YA6. **Handicap:** Youth handicap will be based on KCO rule #8. Adult handicap will be based on 90% of 220.
- YA7. **Squad times:** **SATURDAY for Divisions 4 and 5**, will be at 1:00pm. Check-in time will start at 12:00pm.
Squad times: **SUNDAY for Divisions 1, 2, and 3 only**, will be 8:45am for A-squad and 12:00pm for B-squad. Check-in for A-squad will start at 7:30am and 10:45am for B-squad. There will be announcements and 10 minutes of practice at the start times of each squad. No practice or shadow rolls will be allowed after the start of the block. The center will recondition(re-oil) the lanes between the two squads.
- YA8. **Adult participants** are not required to comply with KCO rule #15 as required for youths, however, it is encouraged. Please, no hats and no tee shirt nor wear apparel or use equipment depicting alcohol, tobacco, and/or gambling during competition. Images, products and/or activities containing profanity, inflammatory or obscene language or imagery will not be allowed.

YA9. Format:

ON SATURDAY: There will be two divisions only (Divisions 4 & 5) bowling 4-games of qualifying. Each will be bowled across four different pairs of lanes in a sweeper format. At the end of each game, bowlers will move one pair right as soon as it is available and immediately begin their next game. After the 4-games of qualifying are completed, the field will be cut to the top four youth/adult teams in both divisions for the stepladder finals. Youth bowlers will bowl all ties. The higher seeded youth bowler will determine their team start first or last. The team finishing last will start first on the left lane with the adult bowler for each team bowling first and the youth bowler bowling last. First round match qualifiers will get two practice rolls on each lane before the match begins. All subsequent qualifiers will get two practice rolls on each lane before their first game. The team that advances will not receive any additional practice rolls. Check-in time for the finals will be **immediately** following the posting of final qualifying scores, and any ties (if applicable) have been decided. The stepladder finals will begin immediately following check-in.

ON SUNDAY: There will be two 4-game qualifying squads for divisions 1, 2, & 3 only. The center will recondition (re-oil) the lanes between the two qualifying squads. Each qualifying block will be bowled across four different pairs of lanes in a sweeper format. At the end of each game, bowlers will move one pair right as soon as it is available and immediately begin their next game. Position standings will be posted after the completion of each squad. After both 4-game qualifying blocks are completed, the field will be cut to the top four youth/adult teams for each division for the stepladder finals. Youth bowlers will bowl all ties. The higher seeded youth bowler will determine their team start first or last. The team finishing last will start first on the left lane with the adult bowler for each team bowling first and the youth bowler bowling last. First round match qualifiers will have the opportunity for 5 minutes of practice before the match begins. All subsequent qualifiers will get two practice rolls on each lane before their first game. The team that advances will not receive any additional practice rolls. Check-in time for the finals will be **immediately** following the posting of final qualifying scores, and any ties (if applicable) have been decided. The stepladder finals will begin immediately following check-in.

YA10. **Youth Stepladder finalists (1 - 4)** will receive a scholarship award. The breakdown for each division will be \$160 for first place, \$120 for second place, \$100 for third place and \$80 for fourth place. If fewer than 98 bowlers (49 teams) participate, these amounts for each division will be adjusted downwards based on the total number of bowler-teams for that tournament. All youth stepladder finalists will receive a plate indicating the place and division they finished in for that tournament. Each youth stepladder finalist will have the option to purchase a plaque with their name on it. Only one style plaque will be offered. The KCO will make every effort to have the plaque available at the next tournament. All awards will be destroyed if not picked up within a year of purchase.

- YA11. **Youth/Adult Champions** will have the option to purchase a Youth/Adult Winner bowling shirt selected by the KCO directors. Payment for these shirts must be made in full before the shirt can be ordered. The lettering on the garment will include the KCO logo, Youth/Adult winner, the year of the current tournament season, and the name of the bowler. Only one shirt or jacket purchase is allowed for each Youth/Adult division winner, but a bowler will be allowed to purchase a shirt each time they are a Youth/Adult division winner. If a bowler does not purchase a shirt at the time they win, they will be allowed to purchase a shirt until the end of the current season. The KCO directors will make every effort to have the shirts available at the next point tournament. All awards will be destroyed if not picked up within a year of purchase.
- YA12. **All participants** in addition and exception to the above stated rules, will be governed by the rules of the current season's USBC/USBC Youth Family Rulebook. This includes all youth participants must abide by **USBC YOUTH Rule 400** in regard to USBC YOUTH Membership Eligibility. A copy of the current season's rulebook is on file with the tournament directors and is available for inspection upon request or visit bowl.com.
